

Interjections express emotion. They are different than any other part of speech because there is no grammatical connection with any other words in the sentence.

They either stand alone, or are set off by commas:

*Oops!* I made a mistake.

*Yippee!* Our team won!

*Oh,* I get it.

Almost every part of speech can be an interjection, and when used this way, become *exclamatory*:

1. Exclamatory noun: *Mom!*
2. Exclamatory verb: *Go away!*
3. Exclamatory adjective: *Fantastic!*
4. Exclamatory adverb: *Really!*
5. Exclamatory pronoun: *Oh my!*
6. Exclamatory conjunction: *As if!*

Interjections are used often in speech, so it's only logical that you'll use them in your dialogue. Oh, we should go write now!
